


Safeguarding and Rescuing Archaeological and Architectural Assets (SARAA) is the first teaching material in Arabic on emergency response for cultural heritage. The material combines the Arabic translation and adaptation of the award-winning Turkish course of the SARAT project expanded with specially selected case studies on destruction or safeguarding of cultural heritage in Lebanon. The project is a collaboration between the British Institute at Ankara and Biladi with the support of the Lebanese University.
